If you have health related issues that may interfere with participation in certain labs due to materials used during certain investigations, you must provide documentation* to your TA from the Office of Student Disabilities Services no later than 14 days prior to that week's Investigation OR submit extra contributions to compensate for the absence (see "B. What if I miss a lab?" on pgG6 of *Investigating Biology* lab manual.
